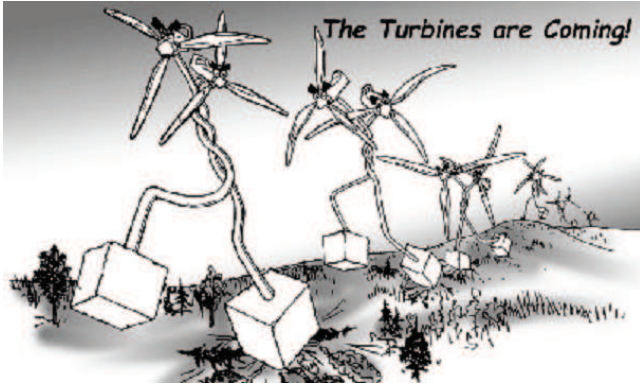

STOP national test centre for gigantic wind turbines

* 550 hectares of forest, the equivalent of more than 1 million trees will be cut down

* The Centre will not become World class as expected

Stop the mega-turbines!

The World's largest industrial test centre for gigantic mega wind turbines will be placed in Østerild and Hjørdemål plantation.

In total 550 hectares of preserved forest will be removed and all together 30 square kilometres of forest, heath, wetlands and meadow will be included to build this large industrial plant.

The wind turbines will be 250 metres tall and can be seen in a radius of 55 kilometres. Blinking lights and measurement towers as tall as the wind turbines will surround the mega wind turbines. All the way from Thy National Park they can be seen very clearly. The wind turbines will be the tallest in the World – at the height of Empire State Building and the pylons of the bridge of Storebælt.

The area, which was appointed by the Danish Ministry of Environment as cultural heritage, lays between Thy National Park and Vejlerne, the largest breeding ground for migratory birds in Northern Europe.

Amidst this grand and wild nature, the closest we get to a wilderness marked by silence and dark nights in Denmark, 7 industrial power plants will be placed, produced by VESTAS and CHINESE PLAYERS.

The companies have received these very cheap "construction sites" by the government. A government that has forced this through with a law that abolishes all directives and decisions that have so far protected this area and its rich wildlife. Sea eagles, cranes, night ravens and the largest population of red deer live here and

will be driven away once the 7 extremely noisy mega wind turbines are placed there.

The law has been forced through in spite of massive protests and in spite of alternative placements for the wind turbines.

The Prime Minister's argument for this project: "Danish competitiveness and employment to the Danish wind turbine industry" is a grotesque distortion of the truth when it comes to the future of Thy. Especially since this project will generate no local employment at the Test Centre. On the contrary, since no one has yet calculated the loss of employment for Thy in the tourist sector once the nature is destroyed.

Help us protest against this outrageous violation of nature. Let us join forces and save the nature of Thy. There is still time!

On October 1st the law will be enforced. The chain saws will be sharpened and the forest will be cut down.

Mark week 40 in your calendar: This week a lot of attention will be drawn towards these initial and terrible steps of building a Test Centre in Thy.
